Dear Holy Spirit Parishioners,

Due to the coronavirus government restrictions, our maximum capacity for Mass attendance is now 150 people. This will impact us a lot, as we are seeing more than 150 people at most of our Sunday Masses.

We are now close to the third Sunday of Advent. This is a season of joy and hope and on the third Sunday of Advent we especially focus on hope. We hear in this Sunday's 2nd reading from St. Paul's letter to the Thessalonians, "Brothers and sisters, rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in ALL circumstances, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you "1 Thess 5:16-24.

And yet we might wonder, where do we find hope today? The Covid pandemic is getting worse. We see around us, lost jobs, despair, depression and anxiety in many lives, and worries about the new year. Pray without ceasing, says St. Paul, to pray every day, in good times, in bad times, when we feel like it and when we don't. To give thanks to God in all circumstances, means that even in times of trial and difficulty, we turn to our Lord and say something like: "Lord, I do not understand why this trial, this sickness or death of a loved one has happened. But, I trust in your love and providence that, in some way, this will work out for the good."

This can be a time to really turn to God and refocus our lives on him. In the solitude of our homes, let us turn to God in prayer.
