

#### From the desk of Fr. David

That first Easter morning and the days following, were days of joy but also of great confusion. There were rumors and unverified reports of: an Empty Tomb, a Missing Body and Jesus' appearances to His followers.

What did this all mean and what were the disciples to make of it?

In today's Gospel, on the road to Emmaus, Jesus catches 2 of his disciples off guard. Jesus is just walking along the road to Emmaus alone and begins to walk with 2 of his disciples, but they do not recognize Him. They are sad, confused and downhearted. But Jesus was not a ghost; he sat down to eat with them and when He broke the bread, they recognized Him. Then, Jesus disappeared.

Jesus' Death and Resurrection was a surprising turn of events for his followers. What happened to them is not unlike what happens in our lives when sudden change is thrust upon us. When our world is turned upside down, we are forced to rethink and reevaluate our lives.

When our lives are changed by: Illness, Death, a Loss or Change in Employment or losses of any kind; we need an anchor, we need something to grasp on to.

This is why it is so important to be rooted in our faith and in a relationship with Jesus, Our Lord. So that, when we meet the storms and changing tides of life, we will meet them with some preparation.

Jesus came to his disciples bringing peace and explaining to them the meaning of his suffering and death. In His Death and Resurrection, our human experiences of pain and suffering are given new meaning.

Again today, we see a theme that we see all through the New Testament; the call to conversion and change of heart. Our Lord is continually calling us to come closer to Him and to let our relationship with Him deepen and Grow.

Our Lord commissions His disciples and sends them forth into the whole world to carry the Good News everywhere. We too, are to be witnesses of Christ in today's world.

Our Lord Jesus is our anchor, our refuge in every storm. Come, Lord Jesus.




### **ROSARY SALE – April 20 - 21**

Presentations will help us to understand and embrace more fully the graces of our baptism and confirmation.






#### **Impact Report 2023**

Four Mysteries of the Rosary are prayed every first Friday of the month at 4 pm in the Chapel.


