

From the desk of Fr. David

The feast of Divine Mercy is a new feast in the Catholic Church. It was declared Divine Mercy Sunday by St John Paul II in the year 2000. At the same celebration he declared St. Faustina to be a saint, the first saint of the new millennium.

St. Faustina is the saint who received numerous visions of Jesus as the Divine Mercy. She was a religious sister in Poland who received these visions beginning in 1931.

Sister Faustina was born August 25, 1905 in Glogowiec, Poland. She entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Mercy in Warsaw in 1924. St. Faustina was instructed to keep a diary of all her mystical experiences. The diary eventually was published as a book entitled "Divine Mercy in my Soul."

Jesus appeared to St. Faustina and instructed her to have some artists paint some images of Divine Mercy. The famous first image is today in the Church of St. Michael Archangel in Vilnius, Lithuania. The second famous image is today at the Shrine of Divine Mercy in Cracow, Poland.

Sister Faustina lived in a number of convents of her congregation in Poland and Lithuania. Until 1939 parts of Lithuania were in Poland.

Jesus informed Sister Faustina of His desire to have a feast declared in honor of His Divine Mercy on the 2nd Sunday of Easter. Under the direction of her

diary was written down in a number of little notebooks, often without punctuation or proper grammar or spelling. Sister Faustina died October 5, 1938 at the age of 33.

In the 1950's copies of the diary were quickly made and translated into Italian and released to the public. Many complaints arose about its content and Rome banned the diary from being promoted in 1958. For the next 20 years the book was banned. During this time the bishop of the diocese of Cracow, Cardinal Karol Wojtyla, worked for many years to have the ban lifted. In early 1978 the ban was finally lifted, and on October 16 of the same year, Cardinal Wojtyla was elected pope; Pope John Paul II.

In the year 2000, Pope John Paul II declared Divine Mercy Sunday (the 2^{nd} Sunday of Easter) to be a new feast for the entire Roman Catholic Church.

On August 17, 2002 (just days after World Youth Day in Toronto) at the new basilica of Divine Mercy in Cracow Pope John Paul II entrusted the whole world to Divine Mercy.





Please note that there will be no overnight Eucharistic Adoration on April 6/7 due to the 40 hours Eucharistic Adoration.




Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter.

Included will be the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Divine Praises, Adoration, Reflection and Benediction.


Fundraiser
